

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1775 Survey was made on the 5th day of January 1776 for Philip Everthart a Freeholder in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Three hundred and Three containing in Breadth East and West on Huttleberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty six feet, Bounded Northward by Huttleberry Street extending Eastward by Lot Number Three hundred and Two Southward by Billberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Three Hundred and four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of February 1775 for the said Philip Everthart by Warrant dated the 4th day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of September 1904.
