



Situate formerly in Dover now in Copewago Township York County containing as above set forth Ninety two acres forty two perches & Allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 234 1/2 acres & allowance. Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson Esqr late D.S. on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1758. in pursuance of a Warrant for 50 a<sup>s</sup> granted to William Ewing dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1755. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 1786, and now at the request of Michael Wilt the present owner of said part the same is examined. Corrected and returned for confirmation - February 16<sup>th</sup> 1822.
