



Situate on Milk & Water Creek in Monroe (formerly Providence) township,

Bedford County, Containing 470 acres 81 perches &c allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c.; Being composed of four surveys as follows Viz; The survey containing 225^{acres} 43 ps. &c. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Joseph Dunken for 200 ac. dated the 27th of June 1789, The one containing 38 ac. 18 ps. &c. was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Lewis Koons for 37 ac. dated the 9th of January 1833, The one containing 47 ac. 162 ps. was also surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Lewis Koons, for 48 ac. dated the 24th of February 1840, And the one containing 159 acres 28 ps. &c. was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of David O. Neal for 150 ac. dated the 28th of April 1853, Returned the 31st of December 1853, To be patented to Lewis Koons.
