On this survey there is a house of a small size, shingle roof & stone chimney, makes a comfortable dwelling in which George Faught was living when the survey was made; Thos Woodside Jacob Millar claims that part of this survey north of the dated line and by virtue of survey & Patent in Right of Jas. Silliman the fact is there was a large survey of about 20⁰⁰ acre made east of this survey which was the property of John Nicholson & sold as his property & was bought by Col. John Mayer who had this Resurveyed about eight years ago, there has been a great uncertainty about the bounds of the original survey the line which bounds this survey on the east is the one made by John Mayer while he was the owner & of whom Millar bought, Jacob Shuman claims that part south of the dated line under the survey in the name of Susanna Silliman under the circumstances the line made by Mayer is not old enough for the original surveys by 10 or 12 year
