



Draft of a tract of land situate in Lamar township Clinton (formerly Centre) County containing one hundred nine acres & one hundred thirty nine perches & allowance of six percent for roads &c. Being part of two adjoining tracts, one thereof surveyed on Warrant granted to Henry Donnel bearing date 6th February 1794 & the other to Jonath? Cook in pursuance of his Warrant dated 22nd September 1794 & which two surveys was originally executed upon and interfered with two older surveys in the names of Aaron Musgrove and David Curry, the above 109^{As} 139 only remaining unincumbered by the Musgrove and (obl.) tracts, Resurveyed the 4th day of March 1840 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property granted to William Richards dated the 3^d day of June A.D. 1839.
