

allowance of six P cent for roads. Surveyed March 15th 1811 in persuance
of a warrant granted to James Elliott dated October 30th 1765 agreeable
to the lines of a former survey, except the peice at A which was included
in the original survey, and the part at B excluded, but their being an exchange made of the said peices and a survey made and return'd of the
adjoining land agreeable to the above.
