



Situate on the west side of Tusseys mountain in West Providence township Bedford county containing 136 acres 97 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by John Bennett Esq. the 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> days of March 1833, being part of a tract containing 429 acres 133 perches and allowance of 6 per cent &c. Originally surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup> of May 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of "John Carver" dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of March 1794. Returned for Jacob Shuse for patenting the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1851
