Dom. 1827 for John Fisher in right of John Harris Jr. Containing Two hundred & Sixty eight acres and one hundred & forty four perches with the usual allowance of six $\frac{A}{S}$. Gt. &c. - It being part of a tract of land surveyed the 18th day of June 1771 for John Harris Jr. by virtue of his order No 2703 dated the 3^d day of April 1769 Pr - William Maclay Esq. then Deputy Surveyor.
