I do Certify that there is Copies of the above
Survey in my office one in the hand writing of
George Woods Esqr late D.S. said to be surveyed
at the above stated time, and one in the hand writing of John Bennett
Esqr D.S. my predecessor, I have been on the ground and find there has be-
en surveys acutually made on the ground agreeable to the above dates,
and that it does bound on the old state Road (now the Turnpike on a
part of it) and on the North side of Rays Town Branch one of the calls
of the said Warrant and it would be impossible to get to the other
call as the distance is between twenty five & thirty Miles, I believe
the Warrant is Executed on the very ground that it was taken -
out for.
