



Situate in Newbury township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 91^{as} & 53^{rs} Perches and allowance, Being part of a larger Tract of Land Containing 232 Acres & Allowance, Originally surveyed by Thomas Cookson late D.S. on the 1st day of May 1744 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Francis Finshaw (alias) Finster bearing date the 12th day of January 1743, The part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 13th day of March 1818 at the request of Peter Stickle the present owner of the said part who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
