


Mountain

N.B. The above described tract was surveyed the 9th day of August 1793 for
George Fox & William Kelly pr Joseph J. Wallis Esq their Deputy Surveyor of North-
umberland County. And again surveyed the 5th day of July A.D. 1816 for the same
pr. Simon Snyder Esq their Deputy Surveyor

There is an interference of the above and a survey made for Abraham Betz
the 10th day of June 1793 by virtue of his Warrant Dated the 14th day of March
1793. Abraham Betz's survey is designated by the dotted lines
