



A Draught of two pieces of land in Derry Township Mifflin County Penn^a. No 1 appears to have been surveyed March 20th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Elton dated August 27th 1794 & said to contain 133° 112 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c. No 2 appears Surveyed Sept 30th 1835 in pursuance of a Warrant to Simon Gro. dated Sept. 28th 1834 Examined & Corrected Nov. 26th 1851 and No 1 found to contain 146° 135 perches & allowance and No 2 found to contain 57° 134 perches and the usual allowance of 6 per cent &c.
