Originally Surveyd unto Henry Hains. on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March 1769 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October A.D. 1747 per James Scull late Deputy Surveyor of Berks County. Resurveyed the above for Daniel - Hehn Aprile 14<sup>th</sup> 1817
