



The Draught of a tract of Land situate in Rye Township, Cumberland County containing one hundred & Seven acres & four Perches & Allowance of six p. cent for Roads &c. Which Appears to have <sup>been</sup> Survey'd the 19<sup>th</sup> June 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Gray Dated Feb'y. 1<sup>st</sup> 1794. The original of which has been Delivere<sup>d</sup> over to me by my predecessor Sam'l Lyon, Esq<sup>r</sup> as an Office paper, the survey must have been Executed under the Direction of Sam'l Lyon, Esq<sup>r</sup> who was the Deputy Surveyor of the District at the Date of the Survey.
