



By VIRTUE of a Warrant dated the 5th day of May A.D. 1864 Surveyed the 12th day of August A.D. 1864 To Phineas G. Goodrich the above described Tract of land, which is wholly unimproved. Situate on a small creek, a tributary to the outlet of Lower Woods Pond, in Lebanon township in the county of Wayne. Containing sixty one acres, one hundred twenty eight perches and an allowance of six per centum.

Survey was actually made by me, the undersigned, upon the ground: all out lines and boundaries fairly and visibly marked at the time, and chain-bearers of good character used, who took a solemn oath, (by me the undersigned, administered), justly and exactly to execute their trust without favor, partiality or affection.
