



The above is the draught of a tract of land called (scramble) situate on the waters of ten-mile creek in East Bethlehem Township Washington County containing eighteen acres and seventy three poles and allowance of six per cent &c surveyed August 3<sup>d</sup> 1836 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John and William Freeman for twenty one acres dated May 5<sup>th</sup> 1836 including a settlement made thereon prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1814 and is now in the possession of the said J & W Freeman.
