



Warr dated the 5th of Feb. 1733,

Duly surveyed on the 20th day of March 1733, to Mr. Graham Harbin a Tract of land situate
in Perry, in the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at a post a corner of Jonathan Harbins land
hence by ^c same North East one hundred & thirty two perches to a post in the line of Elizabeth
Bartlets land hence by ^c same South East eight perches to a corner post of the S. Elizabeth
Bartlets land hence by ^c same North East twenty perches to a post, thence South East
by Vacant land one hundred & eighteen perches to a post, thence by land of David Gerrard
South West one hundred & thirty six perches to a post in the line of Andrew Edges land
thence by ^c same North West ninety perches to a post, thence by ^c g. c. Edges south
west sixteen perches to a corner post of Hans Binders land thence by the same
North west thirty three perches to the place of Beginning containing one
hundred acres with usual allowance.
