

By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 27th day of September anno
Dominii 1789. The above described Tract of Land was Surveyed to
Jacob Hooberter in Tulpehocken Township and Lancaster
County. Beginning at a Black Oak in the line of Jacob
Speer. Thence North by the same 32 rods to a small Black Oak,
Thence east by the S. 6° E. Speer 10 rods to a Spanish Oak &c. Containing
One Hundred & Ninety one acres besides 6 1/2 rods to
y^e 11th mo 12th 1784.
