



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 26th Day of the
6th Month Anno Domini 1738, the above described Tract of Land was
Surveyed unto Leonard Hough in Hanover Township in Lancaster
County, Beginning at a Hickory by Swatara Creek, thence North 18
degrees West by the Improvement of Benjamin Clark 200 perches to a
small Black oak, Thence South 84 degrees West by the same 42 paces to a
stone, Thence North 18 degrees West by the Improvement of Abram and
Williams 49 perches to a post, thence North 97 degrees East by Vacant
Land 140 perches to a Black oak by Swatara Creek, thence down the
same on the several courses hereof to the place of Beginning containing
one hundred and seventy four acres beside the allowance of 6 per cent.
