



On the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1740 a Warrant was granted to Valentine Himmelberger for one hundred acres of land, and on the 30<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> Mo., 1741, 67<sup>th</sup> 100<sup>th</sup> of allowance was surveyed to him in four acres thereof. But as the full quantity was not surveyed to him I have added the above piece to it on the 18<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> Mo., 1746. In pursuance of the above said Warrant, Situated in Bern Township now in Berks County
