



By Virtue of a Warrant bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> of Sept. 1760 I have  
 on the 16<sup>th</sup> of October 1760  
 Surveyed unto Thomas Houghton of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup>, Cooper, a certain Lot  
 of Ground. Situated in the said City on the Bank of Delaware River  
 between Mulberry Street and Sassafras Street. Being part of a  
 Bank and Water Lot, formerly granted to Thomas Holmes, Con-  
 taining in Breadth Twenty feet and in depth forty five feet, Bounded  
 westward with Delaware Front Street, Northward with ground of  
 Jarvis Bywater, Eastward with Delaware Street and Southward  
 with ground now in the tenure of Margaret Clymor, Widow.  
 Nich<sup>o</sup> Scull.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused  
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,  
 this twenty eighth day of February, 1905,
