



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February  
Anno Domini 1736, the above described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto  
Charles Hudson, In the Township of Currawent and County of Lancaster  
Beginning at a Black Oak by Vacant Land, thence East by the same Two Thousand  
and Ninety six perches to White Oak <sup>or</sup> <sub>at</sub> Containing Two Hundred and  
one acres beside the allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads.
