



This Tract of Land surveyed by Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor
 Being date the 26 day of April, 1738. Beginning at a heap of Stone being
 the Corner of Edward Hartley their Rⁿ North East three hundred and twenty
 three pearches by the said Hartley's land to a Corner stone their South East fifty pearches by the
 land of John Bear brought to a heap of stones their South West three hundred and twenty
 pearches by land belonging to the Proprietors to a post near a small white oak upon the
 Carrang. their North West by land out for a Street or Road between Buckingham
 and Salbury fifty three pearches to the place of Beginning. Containing one
 hundred and six acres, the six acres being for Roads as usual, their being a
 Road running through it from one end to the other Surveyed on the 9 day of
 the Month of April 1738. by

Being part of a Tract of 500⁰ in Buckingham Township, reserved for
 the Proprietaries in Buckingham Township Bucks County.
