



By Virtue of a Warr. from the Honble Proprietaries bearing date the twentieth  
day of September Anno Domini 1738. I have Survey'd and laid out unto Benjamin  
Moore in the Township of Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the West side  
of the Quakannamaw river. Two hundred Eighty three acres of land with allowance of six P  
Bank. Beginning at a Hickory a Corner of <sup>16</sup> ~~6~~ <sup>2m</sup> acres land by the same south forty de-  
grees Easter one hundred and forty perches to a Locust South fifty degrees westerly  
twenty three perches to a White Oak a Corner of Uriah Chadwick's land and by the same  
forty  
~~South~~ <sup>forty</sup> degrees Eastward two hundred and two perches to a Swamp Oak. Thence  
south fifty degrees westerly One hundred and sixty perches to a Hickory a corner  
of George Hildebrand's land by the same north forty degrees westerly two hundred  
thirty four perches to a Hickory thence north <sup>ninty</sup> ~~ninteen~~ degrees and a half Easterly two hun-  
dred and twelve perches and a half to the place of Beginning Survey'd May 22<sup>o</sup> 1739.
