



Warrant dated the 10th of Oct 1793.

Surveyed on the twenty seventh day of <sup>23rd June 1734, to Nehemiah
Hector, a certain Tract of Land, Situate on a Branch of the River Duck Kill, called Bemdenwa-
shek, in the County of Phisick. Beginning at a Hickey, being a Corner of Isaac Harris land.
Hence by the same South Thirty two degrees west one hundred and Sixty perches to a post being another
corner of the said Isaac Harris land, thence by Vacant land South West two hundred and Thirteen perches
to a post in the line of Moses Harris land, thence by the same North Seventy degrees west one hund-
red forty nine perches to a post a corner of said Moses's land thence by the same south Sixty degrees
west fourteen perches to a small hickey a corner of Jeremiah Harris land, thence by the same North
west one hundred and Seven perches to an Ash tree another corner of Jeremiah Harris land thence by
Vacant land north Sixty degrees East two hundred and Sixty perches to a White Oak a corner of James Harris
land thence by the same South East Thirly perches to a White Oak standing by the said branch of
Duck Kill. thence the same course across the said branch six perches to a Birch tree,
thence up the several courses of the said branch to the first mentioned hickey
or place of Beginning. Containing five hundred acres with usual allowance.</sup>
