



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 2nd day of September 1738 he aforesaid described Tract of Land situated on Tackicon Creek in the County of Bucks. Containing in the whole One hundred and ninety one acres and a half of six acres to be left for Roads &c Surveyed the 24th day of October 1740 by Edward Scull for John Hutchinson

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this ninth day of March, 1905,
