



Situate in Porter Township Huntingdon County Containing one hundred and seven acres and one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance it being a part of a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Croghan dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1762 this part resurveyed and divided from the residue of said tract the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1851 by the request of Samuel Sprengle the present owner the original survey was said to contain 520 acres & allowance.
