



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3rd day of July 1772 for John Leadlie on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and sixty seven. Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street. Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and sixty six Northward by Gooseberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Two hundred and sixty eight. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 4th day of April 1776 for Adam Heberling by Warrant dated the same day
