In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 1775. I did survey and lay out for Robert Hare of the City of Philadelphia on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1775 a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Manor of Springetsbury at the North End of the said City and without the Limits thereof mark'd in a General Plan of the Lots there Number Sixty Nine Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of the Square Twenty feet and in Length North and South sixty feet. Bounded Southward by the Square aforesaid Westward by Lot Number Sixty six Northward by Lot Number Sixty Eight and Eastward by Lot Number Seventy
