



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Pace Ground situate on the heads of a Run Called Laurel Run about two or three miles eastward of Stoney Creek adjoining Land of John Graff and others in Brothers Valley Township in the County of Bedford. Containing Three hundred and twenty acres and the usual allowance of six p Cent for Roads. Surveyed the seventeenth day of May 1774 for Jacob Hobl in pursuance of a Warrant dated the twentieth day of Dobi 1773
