"We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in ye' Counties of Monongalia, Yohg^a. & Ohio, do hereby certify that Henry Hulse is entitled to four hundred Ac^s of Land in the County of Yohg^a on ye' Saw Mill Run to include his actual Settlement made in ye' year 1772. & also a Right in Pre-emption to four hundred Acres of Land adjoining thereto, Given under our Hds at Cox's Fort the 17th Feby 1780, in ye' 4th year of ye' Commonwealth.
