



By Virtue of two Warrants one bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January 1750 & the other dated 30<sup>th</sup> October 1758 granted to Adam Richbaugh the above Tracts or pieces mark'd A.R. was originally Survey'd to Said Richbaugh Containing the Quantities Respectively inserted in them, and the remainder to Peter Hain on two Warrants dated the 16<sup>th</sup> March 1743. The whole Resurvey'd on 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1782 unto Martin Noaker agreeable to the ~~whole~~ above described Draught Situated in Bern Township Berks County Containing Two hundred & fifty four Acres and the Allow of Six P Cent.
