



Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Heidelberg, in the County of Berks, containing one hundred and nine acres, eighty-four perches, and the allowance of six per cent for roads. Surveyed for John and Peter Fidler, Samuel Stouch and Isaac Boone and Joseph Fryberger, the twenty-first day of September, 1872, being part of a larger tract of one hundred and three acres, one hundred and fifty-three perches, and allowance. Originally surveyed in accordance of a warrant granted to John Hetrig dated the 16th day of the 6th month of 1744.
