



Situate in Codorus Township York County No. 1 Surveyed the 3d.

day of November 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant for 100a. granted to Bernard Hamshire dated Sep^t 5th. 1785 but was afterwards found to have been run foul of some of the adjoining lands, but was rectified the 16th. day of November 1787 and a new Return made — No. 2 & 3 Surveyed the 10th. day of September 1789 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Bernard Hamshire for 60a. dated April 29th. 1789 directing the same to be Surveyed in two pieces — And the whole in pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey granted to Ludwick Frazier dated 18th. July 1794 to Correct Errors the 23d. day of September 1794.
