



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Franklin Township
 Franklin (late Cumberland) County Containing One hundred
 and twenty five acres and fifty one perches & allowance
 of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract
 of Two hundred and forty three acres and one hundred and
 thirty seven perches &c. which was Surveyed September 24th
 1766 to George Eaker on his Order of Surveyor dated August 20th
 1766 A.D. 1766. Surveyed and laid off from the other part
 of the tract September 10th 1800 by Daniel Henderson
 formerly a Deputy Surveyor as appears by an official
 Draught thereof remaining in my Office.
