

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 8th
1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Abraham
Kirkpatrick for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth
day of February 1794 including the Venango Path
about Eight Miles from Pittsburgh about a mile to
the northward of the Seven Mile Run North and
west of the River Ohio on the Waters of Allegheny
Called Great flat Containing four Hundred thirty three
Acres three quarters and thirteen poles together with
the usual Allowance of six per cent
