



Situate in Napier township Bedford County containing 127 acres 10 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c Surveyed by Michael Reed Esq. for Henry Shepler the 31st of May 1852 according to the original marks upon the ground and the courses changed to the true bearings.

Being part of a tract that originally contained 402^{acres} 8 all.

Surveyed the 16th of October 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of John Jones for 400 acres dated the 16th of June 1794 (To be patented to Henry Shepler)
