


Del.-PIKE.



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 17th December 1784 Surveyed
the 2^d October 1787 to Elizabeth Ingram the above described
tract of land situate on a branch that Empties into little Bushkill-
at Smiths Meadows about one mile from Shoholy road and about
four miles from Delaware River in Northampton County. Contain-
ing Three hundred Acres one hundred and fifty perches and the
Allowance of Six p. Cent. &c.
