



The above is a draft of that portion of the Richard Jones Warrant lying between the Isaiah Jones Warrant and the Purchase Line of Nov. 5, 1774. That portion of the Richard Jones Warrant lying North of the Purchase Line is covered by a Warrant granted to Dr. W^m Cathcart, under whose Patent the present owners hold title.

A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Green and County of Indiana, containing Twenty nine acres One hundred Thirty seven perches and allowance of six percent for roads, etc. Surveyed for Ellsworth Manner the Twelfth day of November 1903, it being part of a larger tract containing Three Hundred Fifteen acres, — perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Richard Jones dated the Twentieth day of January 1774. ~~1780~~
