


John Kern



Draft of a tract of land situated in Washington township in the county of Lehigh Containing 12 Acres 99 perches and Allowance of Six per cent for roads & (the larger tract containing 12<sup>9</sup>.52<sup>rs</sup> ac. and the smaller 47<sup>rs</sup>) Surveyed for John Kern and Daniel Kern the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1870 being a part of a larger tract of 16 Acres 100 perches and allowance originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Frederick Kern dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1748.
