



Surveyed the Above described tract of Land on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August 1815,  
 For Jas. Richards in Right of Andrew Kinhead in trust, in pursuance of An  
 Improvement Warrant granted to Andrew Kinhead Bearing date 20<sup>th</sup>  
 day of June 1785. Containing Three hundred & twelve Acres & fifty Nine  
 perches & Allowance of Six pr Cent &c Situate in the New purchase Pine  
 Creek Township Lycoming County. Bounded on the South by the West Bra-  
 nch of the Susquehanna - on the east by Hugh White Esq<sup>r</sup> on the West  
 by Robt Crawford in right of Wm Cook And on the North by Vacant  
 land. The improvement is supposed to be Fifty Acres Cleared. A House &  
 Barn thereon. Begun in the year 1774 by Revd John Kinhead.
