

But now in Hopewell Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth
163² & 110 Perches and allowance of six Per Cent &c. Being part of a larger
Tract of 215² & 116 Perches and allowance &c. Originally Surveyed by Willi-
am Hersey late D.S. on the 26th of the 1st M^o 1786, In Pursuance of a War-
rant for 100² Granted to David Hamilton bearing date the 15th day of
May A.D. 1766. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the sa-
id larger Tract of Land on the 22^d day of March A.D. 1811 at the request
of the owner James Patterson who desired the same to be returned
for confirmation.
