



SITUATE in Paradise Township in the County of York containing as above set forth fifty four acres & allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of 259<sup>as</sup> & 133 p.s. & allowance, which was originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in May 1768, in pursuance of a Warrant for 250<sup>as</sup> Granted to Hance Hamilton bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July Anno Domini 1809 for George Yake the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught.
