



A DRAUGHT of 100^a 106 perches of land with allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c. part of a larger tract which appears to have been Surveyed June 29th 1768 in pursuance of an order Granted to Margaret McDonald dated July 11th 1767 No 4157 Resurveyed in part & corrected Dec. 5th 1851 and found the part inclosed by black lines to contain 100^a 106 ps. & allowance - The small piece at the north corner inclosed by dotted lines represents 20 acres belonging to Wm Hough a part of Cuthbert Landreth the outside dotted lines on the West side of the Survey show the boundaries of John Thomas Warrant dated August 9th 1783 and called St. Thomas. the inside dotted lines show the residue of Margaret McDonald.
