



A DRAUGHT of a Tract of Land situated in Washington Township Franklin County (late Antrim Township Cumberland County) containing One hundred and sixty seven acres and one hundred and thirty eight perches and allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed September 14<sup>th</sup> 1772 for John Johnston in pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to William Beaty Junr Dated February 17<sup>th</sup> 1767 No 2806 by James Cunningham Asst. of John Armstrong Esq<sup>r</sup> formerly a Deputy Surveyor, as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in my office.
