



A DRAFT of a tract of land situated in Brady township Huntingdon County. Containing twenty five acres and one hundred and four perches and the allowance of six pr. centum being part of a larger tract of land which was surveyed for James Kelly the 15th day of May A.D. 1793 in pursuance of his warrant dated the 31st day of October 1792. This part divided from the residue of said tract the 18th day of September A.D. 1858.
