Draft of an Island in the Allegheny River between the Townships of Cranberry and Sandy Creek, Venango County, being the first Island below the Allegheny Bridge which crosses sd. River at Franklin, and nearest the Eastern bank of sd. River, opposite lands of R. Irwin on the East & North East, and land of Eveleth & Bissel, and Hoover & others, (formerly Robert Brandon) on the West & South West; which sd. Island is at Beck's ripple in sd. River.

Survey'd 20th March 1861 for Col. James P. Hoover in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him dated 15th March A. D. 1861.
