



THE ABOVE is the draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Ten mile creek in Morris Township Washington County Called triangle and containing five acres and one hundred and thirty-three poles and allowance of six per cent executed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1836 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Hathaway for ten acres dated March 28<sup>th</sup> day 1836 on which an improvement has been made prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1814.
