



Situate on the west side of Dunning's Mountain about three quarters or one mile from the three springs on the Frankstown vally side in Greenfield Township Bedford County Containing 86^{sq} & 102 perches and allowance of six per Ct for Roads &c. Surveyed for Conrad Imler the 12th day of Sept 1795 under the directions of George Woods Jr. late D.S. Resurveyed the 17th day of December 1830 on Warrant for 100^{sq} dated 14th Feby. 1794.
