

of Henry Harry 25 perches to a post Thence East North East by
the same Land 5 perches to a Black Oak Thence North North West
by other Land of Evan Lloyd late of Evan Price 10 perches to ye
place of Beginning Containing One Hundred and Forty acres be-
side ye allowance of 31 1/2 Cent for Roads.
